Why We Do The Things We Do

**Reverence: The genuflection
or bow & kissing the Altar:**

Come in, let us bow and bend low, let us kneel before the God Who made us! [Ps95:6]

The genuflection or bow is a sign of love and deep respect. Our genuflection or bow acknowledges Christ’s Presence, with us, in the Tabernacle. The Celebrant(s) and attendants also genuflect or bow to the Blessed Sacrament before stepping on to the Sanctuary.

The Priest’s kissing the altar is a profound sign of how precious the altar is, central to our worship and where the consecration of the Mass will take place.
