The Sign of the Cross

The Sign of the Cross is the simplest Catholic prayer and blessing, and from the 2nd Century, Christians commonly blessed themselves with the Sign of the Cross; by which we remember Christ's mandate at His Ascension to make disciples of the nations, baptising thein in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. [Mt28:19] As we make the Sign of the Cross we profess our belief in the Blessed Trinity and immediately call ourselves into the loving Presence of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This blessing is also used with significance in Baptism, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick and when we receive the ashes on Ash Wednesday. [Edited from This is the Mass p.13]
